Background

- 2. The Pacific migration landscape continues to evolve and experience significant changes with increasing connectivity to new international destinations linking the Pacific to new regions outside of the Pacific.

In response to these operational changes and challenges, members throughout the region at varying levels of vulnerability have collectively operated under an evolving operational migration landscape. This session provides an opportunity for members to discuss their experiences and challenges in their respective operational environment and provides lessons that members can share and learn from in addition to identifying commonalities and regional approaches that PIDC can consider to support members.
